**MODIFICATION IN SUMMER SEMESTER RULES  
(Approved in the 7<sup>th</sup> Senate Meeting, Item no. – 7.08)**

The modification for the summer semester rules are as given below:

1. Only theory papers can be offered during the Summer Semester depending upon the needs of the students and availability of instructors for offering the course in the department.
2. The duration of the Summer Semester is about 9 weeks, which requires the teaching load per week for each offered course to be double that of the normal semester load. The credit will remain same as in a regular semester.
3. The teaching/learning process of the regular semesters and the Summer Semester will be subjected to continuous evaluation process, i.e., mid semester and end semester examination, quizzes etc.
4. Each student needs to register for the summer semester as per the academic calendar.
5. The maximum number of courses that can be registered by a student in Summer Semester will be limited to Two (2) full courses. One modular course will be half of a full course.
6. Classes will be conducted regularly irrespective of the number of the registered students. The attendance requirement will be same as that of regular semesters.
7. The tuition fee and semester fee for Summer Semester will be 50% of the tuition fee and semester fee of the regular semester.
8. In addition to Theory papers, final year B. Tech. (Project) can also be offered during Summer Semester.
9. Instructors/Departments will announce summer courses as early as possible immediately after Winter End Semester Examination.
