
NOTIFICATION

ALLOWING UG STUDENTS TO CLEAR ONE MANDATORY COURSE EACH FROM THE BASKET OF COURSES OF MANAGEMENT STUDIES AND HUMANITIES & SOCIAL SCIENCES ANYTIME DURING THE ENTIRE PERIOD OF UG ACADEMIC PROGRAM

As per the existing course structure of the Undergraduate Program (CBCS) two mandatory courses, one from Management Studies and another from Humanities and Social Science (out of the list of courses prescribed in their respective baskets) are to be completed by all the UG students in their 5th and 6th semester (as per the department-wise distribution of the MS and HSS courses between 5th and 6th semesters).

The Institute Senate in its 21st meeting held on 08 December 2021 vide Agenda item no. – 21.12 has decided that MS/HSS course, a non-departmental course, will be treated as an Open Elective. At the same time it will be mandatory for all the UG students to clear at least one MS and HSS course each at the time of completion of the OE credits requirements in any semester during the entire period of their academic program instead of existing practice of doing it in Fifth and Sixth semester.

This change will be applicable with effect from 2022-23 Monsoon Semester for the year 2020 onwards admitted students.
