
Very recently, the IIT (ISM) campus has been witnessing water crisis as the major source of water supply from Maithon has become very irregular and unpredictable. Also, many of the existing internal borings /dug wells in the campus have dried up completely.

In order to meet the crisis, it is requested to rationalise the consumption of water wherever possible.

To tied over the crisis, the water supply to residential areas will be made once a day in the morning hours only instead of twice a day, till the situation improves. In addition, the following measures may please be adopted to minimize the water consumption: -

1. Use of running water for washing cars/bikes etc. should be avoided
2. Hand sprinklers may be used instead of running water for gardening purpose.
3. All taps in the residence may be closed while not in use.
4. Any water leakage may be informed instantly to CMU.
5. Use of running water for washing court yard/street etc. should be avoided.
